An Effort of the Students and Educators for Making Schools Safer

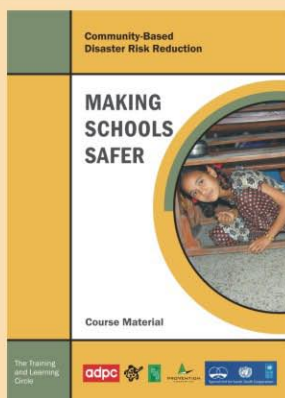
The Safer Schools Campaign - initiated by the All India Disaster Mitigation Institute (AIDMI) is an effort with more than 1060 vulnerable schools and 32,000 students/school staff and agencies for making schools safer. The Campaign is carrying out various activities for children's safety in disaster-affected and disaster prone Assam, Bihar, Gujarat, Jammu & Kashmir, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal states, including Union Territories Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Puducherry of India as well as neighbouring countries like Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Maldives and Myanmar along with jointly doing with UN agencies, INGO/NGO, national/local authorities and universities.



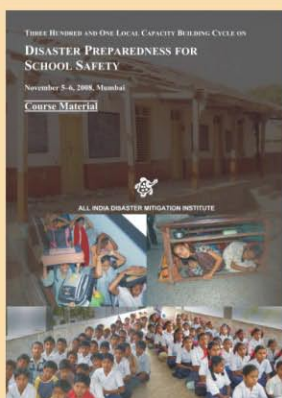
Trainings on School Safety Subjects: Over 120 training programmes covering 5404 participants covering INGO/NGO representatives, staff from education department, officials of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, teachers, administrative staff of schools and students. Subjects include Disaster Preparedness for School Safety; Scientific Awareness; Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Education; Disaster Mitigation with Children; Emergency Medical Response; and Road Safety.



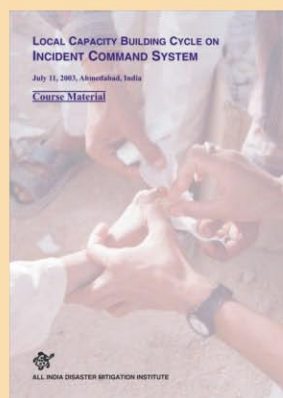
